

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What? The Expedition for the Earth is an adventure trek where participants raise funds and awareness to help preserve wild places in Nova Scotia while visiting fascinating protected places around the world. Participants pay for their own costs of the trip, airfare and commit to a fundraising goal of \$2,500.

Why? The Nova Scotia Nature Trust protects Nova Scotia's most unique natural areas, from old-growth forests and pristine coastline to habitat for imperiled wildlife and plants. There is an urgent need to take action and protect our irreplaceable natural places that are threatened by development and resource use. The Nature Trust ensures that those places are conserved for future generations to enjoy.

Where? The third Expedition for the Earth adventure trek will take place in Ecuador from September 22-29th. The trek will begin in Termas Papallacta in the Upper Amazon, a region of cloud forests and waterfalls. Then participants will travel north to the Otavalo region where they will visit the Cotacachi- Cyapas Ecological Reserve, hike Cuiocha "Guinea Pig" Lake and summit Fuya Fuya.

Who? The Expedition for the Earth: Ecuador will be expertly guided by Berg Adventure International's owner and founder, Wally Berg. Wally is world-renowned for his trekking expertise and mountaineering accomplishments, with over two decades of experience leading expeditions including multiple ascents of the Seven Summits.
